INDIA DRIVING STRONG GROWTH IN FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT (FDI)

FDIs have propelled India's equity markets to new heights, increasing their investments from US\$ 4.01 billion as on March 2001 to US\$ 71.28 billion as on March 2024 with a cumulative amount of US\$ 1.03 trillion between April 2000 to September 2024. GROWING HOUSEHOLD SAVINGS: A PILLAR OF ECONOMIC RESILIENCE

Net financial savings of Indian Households increased from ₹ 2.06 Lakh crores as on March 2000 to ₹ 14.2 Lakh crores as on March 2023 accounting for about 29% of total Household savings as on FY 2023. Net financial savings refer to the difference between financial assets (such as currency, deposits, shares and debentures, mutual funds, insurance, etc.) and financial liabilities (including loans and advances).
